



Good afternoon, Everyone! We hope you enjoy this installment of our newsletter, and this little historical segment which is focused on the Conclave held in 2001 in Grand Rapids, MN. A number of NIAHC

members attended that event, either driving through Chicago or going up through the UP and along the southern shore of Lake Superior. Either way it was a haul to get there.



Pictures #1 and 2 show Kurt and Vella Anderson's 1957 100-6 which had just been restored. Unfortunately, a problem developed with the newly rebuilt engine, causing an immediate need for a trailer. Kurt says that this happened in the wilds of Northern Michigan, the middle of nowhere. While they were trying to decide what to do, a guy on his way to Conclave hauling a racing Healey on a trailer,
